
CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR

on Judiciary

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE THE SUM OF EIGHTEEN
THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$18,000) FOR THE ESTABLISH-
MENT OF PERMANENT OR TEMPORARY STATIONS AND
EQUIPMENT FOR INSPECTION OF VEHICLES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds
3 in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund of the Government of Guam,
4 the sum of Eighteen Thousand Dollars (\$18,000) for the purpose of constructing
5 permanent or temporary stations, and the purchase of equipment, in accordance
6 with Section 23148 of the Government Code of Guam.

7 Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
