Substitute bill by Committee on Judiciary

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE THE SUM OF EIGHTEEN THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$18,000) FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF PERMANENT OR TEMPORARY STATIONS AND EQUIPMENT FOR INSPECTION OF VEHICLES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund of the Government of Guam, the sum of Eighteen Thousand Dellars (\$18,000) for the purpose of constructing permanent or temporary stations, and the purchase of equipment, in accordance with Section 23148 of the Government Code of Guam.

Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure,
