on JudiciaryAN ACT TO AMEND SUBSECTION 19566.0102 OF
SECTION 19566, CHAPTER 6, TITLE XX, GOVERN-
MENT CODE OF GUAM, WITH RESPECT TO ACCESS
TO WAREHOUSES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Subsection 19566.0102 of Section 19566, Chapter 6,
3 Title XX, Government Code of Guam, is hereby amended to read as follows:4 ".0102. Whenever beverages are placed in a ware-
5 house under bond in accordance with Subsection 19566.01
6 and applicable regulations promulgated by the Tax
7 Commissioner, no person shall be allowed access to the
8 warehouse except the Tax Commissioner or his representative,
9 the owner of the warehouse or his representative, persons
10 authorized by Section 25501, Government Code of Guam, and
11 persons authorized by regulation of the Tax Commissioner.
12 All such access shall be in accord with applicable regu-
13 lations promulgated by the Tax Commissioner."14 Section 2. This Act shall take effect on the first day of the
15 second month following approval by the Governor.

16 Section 3. This Act is an urgency measure.
