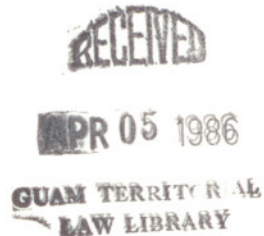

AN ACT TO REAPPROPRIATE THE SUM OF FIVE
HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$500,000) TO
PROVIDE COURTHOUSE FACILITIES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. The monies appropriated in Public Law 5-93 and Public
3 Law 6-9 for the purpose of establishing a Court Housing Fund are hereby
4 reapportioned, in accordance with the provisions contained in those laws,
5 in the entire amount of the Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000) for the
6 purpose of constructing courthouse facilities.

7 Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
