
CERTIFICATE OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR

AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR VARIOUS  
NECESSARY CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS AND FOR  
OTHER PURPOSES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. There are hereby appropriated from any available funds  
3 in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the following sums for the  
4 purposes set forth herein:

- 5 (a) To supplement prior appropriations for  
6 construction of additional facilities at  
7 the Department of Agriculture \$ 7,544
- 8 (b) For the continuation of the parks,  
9 beaches and monuments development  
10 program, and to construct swimming  
11 facilities at Agat and Hoover Park 25,000
- 12 (c) For necessary electrical repairs at  
13 the Governor's Palace 6,000
- 14 (d) To supplement prior appropriation  
15 for construction of the Dededo  
16 Municipal Building 6,000
- 17 (e) For conversion of the psychiatric ward  
18 of the Guam Memorial Hospital into an  
19 addition to the maternity ward 7,000
- 20 ~~(f) To continue prosecution of protests~~

Section 2. The appropriations made by this Act shall be effective immediately, and shall be available for all expenses incident to the purposes for which made. Every appropriation made herein shall continue in full force and effect and shall be available until expended for the project for which the appropriation is made or until the project is completed. Appropriations made for capital improvements under this and prior Acts may be used for the employment of technical, professional and other skilled personnel for use on capital improvement projects for which such appropriations were made; such personnel may be employed on such terms as authorized by the Governor and may include the furnishing of travel, transportation and housing; the provisions of Title V, Government Code of Guam, shall not apply to such personnel, except as may be authorized by the Governor.

Section 3. This Act is an urgency measure.
