AN ACT TO ADD ARTICLE IV TO CHAPTER 4, TITLE XIII, GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM, RELATING TO SOIL AND WATER CONSERVATION, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAR:

Section 1. A new Article IV is hereby added to Chapter 4.
Title XIII. Government Code of Guam, to road as follows:

"ARTICLE IV

Soil and Water Conservation

Section 12375. Conservation Program: Responsibility. The Department of Agriculture shall be responsible for the development of a program for the conservation, development and utilization of water and soil resources, and for the control and prevention of soil erosion.

Section 12376. Same: Authorization. In carrying out its responsibilities under this Article the Department is authorized to:

- (a) Develop plans for the conservation of soil and water resources and the control and prevention of erosion, and to publish or otherwise bring such plans to the attention of land owners and occupiers of land in Guam.
- (b) Conduct surveys, investigations and research relating to soil and water conservation and the prevention and control of erosion, and to publish and disseminate information concerning such subjects.
- (c) Conduct demonstrations relative to the conservation of soil and water resources and the prevention and control of erosion, and carry out preventive and

control measures on government land. 1 (d) Cooperate with other land owners and occupiers in the development of crosion control and water 3 resources conservation programs. 4 (e) Construct, improve and maintain any structures 5 necessary for carrying out the purposes of this Article. 7 Section 12377. Reservation of Government Land, The Department shall consult with and advise the Director of Land 8 Management with respect to the reservation of government land 9 pursuant to Section 13301 of the Government Code. 10 Section 12370. Compliance with Federal Programs. 11 With the approval of the Governor, the Department of 12 Agriculture shall serve as the appropriate agency for compliance 13 14 with the terms of any Federal program concerning the development of plans for conservation, development, and utilization of 15 mater and related land resources." 16 Section 2. Section 13517, Government Code of Guam, is hereby 17 amended to read as follows: 18 "Section 13517. Same: Reservations in deed or lease. 19 In every deed or grant, lease or contract for the sale of 20 government real property, the government shall reserve such 21 rights and easements as may be necessary or desirable for any 22 23 public use or purpose, present or future, including water and mineral rights in the real property so conveyed." 24 Section 3. This Act is an urgency measure. 25
