AN ACT TO PROVIDE AN APPROPRIATION TO SUPPLEMENT THE PRIOR APPROPRIATIONS MADE BY SECTION 3 OF PUBLIC LAW 5-100.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM: Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of five thousand dollars (\$5,000) to supplement the appropriation made by Section 3 of Public Law 5-100 to the Office of the Governor for the prosecution of protests before the United States Maritime Commission against an increase in ocean freight rates between the continental United States and Guam for the purpose of paying unpaid costs and reimbursing counsel for certain costs incurred in connection therewith.
