AN ACT TO PROVIDE AN APPROPRIATION TO
SUPPLEMENT THE PRIOR APPROPRIATIONS
MADE BY SECTION 3 OF PUBLIC LAW 5-100.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from any available
3 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of
4 five thousand dollars (\$5,000) to supplement the appropriation made
5 by Section 3 of Public Law 5-100 to the Office of the Governor for
6 the prosecution of protests before the United States Maritime
7 Commission against an increase in ocean freight rates between the
8 continental United States and Guam for the purpose of paying unpaid
9 costs and reimbursing counsel for certain costs incurred in
10 connection therewith.
