AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 23110, GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM, RELATING TO DECALCOMANIA ON WINDSHIELDS AND WINDOWS OF VEHICLES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 23110, Government Code of Guam, is hereby

amended to read as follows:

"Section 23110. Windshields and Windows.

(a) No person shall drive any motor vehicle upon a highway with any sign, poster, card, sticker, or other nontransparent material upon the front windshield, side wings, windwings, side or rear windows of the vehicle. except that such signs, posters, cards, stickers, or other materials may be placed on said windshield within a seven-inch square in the lower corner farthest removed from the driver's position or upon the side windows of the vehicle to the rear of the driver and so placed that said materials will not obstruct the driver's clear view of approaching traffic; except that this subjection shall not apply to any current decalcomania issued by the Armed Forces of the United States, or the Government of Guem.

(b) Every permanent windshield on a motor vehicle shall be equipped with a device for removing rain or other moisture or substance from such windshield, and such device shall be so constructed and installed as to be controlled or operated by the operator of the vehicle."

Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
