
CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 23110, GOVERNMENT
CODE OF GUAM, RELATING TO DECALCOMANIA ON
WINDSHIELDS AND WINDOWS OF VEHICLES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 23110, Government Code of Guam, is hereby
3 amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 23110. Windshields and Windows.

5 (a) No person shall drive any motor vehicle upon a
6 highway with any sign, poster, card, sticker, or other
7 nontransparent material upon the front windshield, side
8 wings, windwings, side or rear windows of the vehicle,
9 except that such signs, posters, cards, stickers, or
10 other materials may be placed on said windshield within
11 a seven-inch square in the lower corner farthest removed
12 from the driver's position or upon the side windows of
13 the vehicle to the rear of the driver and so placed that
14 said materials will not obstruct the driver's clear view
15 of approaching traffic; except that this subsection shall
16 not apply to any current decalcomania issued by the Armed
17 Forces of the United States, or the Government of Guam.

18 (b) Every permanent windshield on a motor vehicle
19 shall be equipped with a device for removing rain or other
20 moisture or substance from such windshield, and such device
21 shall be so constructed and installed as to be controlled
22 or operated by the operator of the vehicle."

23 Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
