AN ACT TO REPEAL SECTION 23116 AND TO ENACT A NEW SECTION 23116, CHAPTER 2, TITLE XXIV. GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAR, PENTAINING TO PASSENGERS IN BOTOR VEHICLES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAN:

Section 1. Section 23116, Government Code of Gunz, is hereby repcaled and a new Section 23116, Chapter 2. Title XXIV, Government Code of Gunz, is hereby enacted to read as follows:

"Section 23116. Obstructing briver's View or Interfering with Control of Mechanism. (a) No person shall drive a vehicle when it is so leaded, or when there are in the front seat such a number of persons, in excess of three as to obstruct the view of the driver to the front or sides of the vehicle or as to interfere with the driver's control over the driving mechanism of the vehicle." Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
