AN ACT TO REPEAL SECTION 23339 AND TO ENACT
A NEW SECTION 23339 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE
OF GUAM, RELATING TO TRANSFER OF REGISTRATION
OF MOTOR VEHICLES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 23339 of the Government Code of Guam is hereby
3 repealed, and a new Section 23339 is hereby enacted to read as follows:

4 "Section 23339. Transfer of Registration.

5 (a) Registration expires on transfer by owner. Whenever
6 the owner of a registered vehicle transfers or assigns
7 his title, or interest thereto, the registration of such
8 vehicle shall expire. The owner shall remove the regis-
9 tration plates therefrom and forward the same to the
10 Department of Finance, or may have such plates and the
11 registration number thereon assigned to another vehicle
12 as provided in Section 23334(e).

13 (b) New owner must secure new registration. The
14 transferee before operating or permitting the operation
15 of such vehicle upon a highway shall apply for and obtain
16 the registration thereof, as upon an original registration,
17 except as otherwise permitted in (c) or (d) below.

18 (c) Transfers to dealers. When the transferee of
19 a vehicle is a dealer who holds the same for resale and
20 lawfully operates the same under dealer's number plates
21 or when the transferee does not drive such vehicle or
22 permit it to be driven upon the highways, such transferee
23 shall not be required to obtain a new registration of such

1 vehicle.

2 (d) Transfer by operation of law. Whenever the
3 title or interest of an owner in or to a registered vehicle
4 shall pass to another otherwise than by voluntary transfer,
5 the registration shall expire and the vehicle shall not be
6 operated upon the highways unless and until the person
7 entitled to possession of such vehicle shall apply for
8 and obtain the registration thereof."

9 Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
