Introduced by

Committee on Rules, by request of the Governor in accordance with Section 6 (b) of the Organic Act of Guam.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 4223, CHAPTER 3, TITLE V. GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM, RELATIVE TO PAYMENT OF CUSTODIAL AND AUDIT FRES OF THE GOVERNMENT OF GUAM RETIREMENT FUND.

DE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAR:

Section 1. Section 4223, Government Code of Guam, is hereby

amended to read as follows:

"Section 4223, Employees of fund. The director may employ such clerical, medical or other assistance as shall be necessary for the proper administration of the fund. The director may also engage actuarial or other professional service to assist in the preparation of the annual reports, to advise in matters of policy and to make the periodic actuarial surveys. The costs and expenses of the administration of the fund shall be paid by the government; provided, however, that any custodial and audit fees incurred in connection with the financial operations of the fund shall be paid out of said fund. At least once every five years as actuarial survey and investigation shall be made of the operating experience of the fund. including a study of the rates of mortality, disability, retirement, separations and other essential factors relating to the operations of the fund. Such survey shall also provide for a verification or redetermination of the rates of contribution by the government.

Legal services shall be provided by the government through its appropriate department, and the official of the government serving in the capacity of treasurer of the government shall be ex-officio treasurer of the fund."

Section 2. This act is an urgency measure.
