AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 1(g), PUBLIC LAW 80,
SIXTH GUAM LEGISLATURE, MAKING AN APPROPRIATION
FOR THE TRAINING OF RETARDED CHILDREN.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 1(g), Public Law 80, Sixth Guam Legislature,
3 is hereby amended to read as follows:

4 "(g) To supplement the prior appropriation of Public
5 Law 46, Sixth Guam Legislature, to provide facilities for
6 the training of retarded children \$ 2,000."

7 Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
