BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 1(g), Public Law 80, Sixth Guam Legislature,
is hereby amended to read as follows:

"(g) To supplement the prior appropriation of Public
Law 46. Sixth Guam Legislature, to provide facilities for
the training of retarded children \$ 2,000."
