AN ACT TO REPEAL SECTION 23114 AND TO ENACT
A NEW SECTION 23114 OF CHAPTER 2, TITLE XXIV,
GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM, PERTAINING TO VEHICLES
TRANSPORTING EXPLOSIVES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 23114 of Chapter 2, Title XXIV, Government
3 Code of Guam, is hereby repealed, and a new Section 23114 is hereby enacted
4 to read as follows:

5 "Section 23114. Vehicles Transporting Explosives.

6 Any person operating any vehicle transporting any explosive
7 as a cargo or part of a cargo upon a highway shall at all
8 times comply with the provisions of this section:

9 (a) Said vehicle shall be marked or placarded
10 on each side and the rear with the word 'Explosives'
11 in letters not less than three (3) inches high.

12 (b) Every said vehicle shall be equipped with
13 at least one fire extinguisher, filled and ready for
14 immediate use, and placed at a convenient point on the
15 vehicle so used.

16 (c) The Director of Public Safety is hereby
17 authorized and directed to promulgate such additional
18 regulations governing the transportation of explosives
19 and other dangerous articles by vehicles upon the
20 highways as he shall deem advisable for the protection
21 of the public."

22 Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
