AN ACT TO BEPEAL SECTION 23114 AND TO ENACT A NEW SECTION 23114 OF CHAPTES 2. TITLE XXIV. GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAR, PERTAINING TO VEHICLES TRANSPORTING EXPLOSIVES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAR:

Section 1. Section 23114 of Chapter 2, Title XXIV, Government Code of Guam, is hereby repealed, and a new Section 23114 is hereby exacted to read as follows:

"Section 23114. Vehicles Transporting Explosives.

Any person operating any vehicle transporting any explosive as a cargo or part of a cargo upon a highway shall at all times comply with the provisions of this section:

- (a) Said wehicle shall be marked or placarded on each side and the rear with the word "Explosives" in letters not less than three (3) inches high.
- (b) Every said vehicle shall be equipped with at least one fire extinguisher, filled and ready for immediate use, and placed at a convenient point on the vehicle so used.
- authorized and directed to promulgate such additional regulations governing the transportation of explosives and other dangerous articles by vehicles upon the highways as he shall deem advisable for the pratection of the public."

Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
