AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE OPERATION
OF THE EXECUTIVE BRANCH OF THE GOVERNMENT OF
GUAM FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 1963,
AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. The following sums are hereby appropriated from any
available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund for the
operation of the Executive Branch of the Government of Guam for the fiscal
year ending June 30, 1963:

Section 2. A 10% differential is hereby authorized to be paid
personnel for duty on a twenty-four-hour basis, as administratively determined.

Section 3. Any grant received from the United States Government as
general fund revenue, is specifically authorized for the purpose, or purposes,
for which such grant is made.

Section 4. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of Six Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$600,000) for the Executive Branch's contribution to the Government of Guam Retirement Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1963.

Section 5. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000) for allowable travel and transportation expense of the Executive Branch of the Government of Guam for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1963.

Section 6. This Act is an urgency measure.
