AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR NECESSARY
CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS AND FOR OTHER
PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. There are hereby appropriated from any available
funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the following sums
for the purposes set forth herein:

Section 2. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$13,000 to complete renovation of Department of Finance Warehouses and for other office improvements.

Section 3. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$63,300 for the replacement of automotive equipment for the Executive Branch of the Government of Guam.

Section 4. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$5,000 for the purpose of supplementing capital improvement appropriations in accordance with Section 6118.1, Government Code of Guam.

Section 5. The appropriations made by this Act shall be effective immediately, and shall be available for all expenses incident to the purposes for which made. Every appropriation made herein shall continue in full force and effect and shall be available until expended for the project for which the appropriation is made or until the project is completed. Appropriations made for capital improvements under this and prior Acts may be used for the employment of technical, professional and other skilled personnel for use on capital improvement projects for which such appropriations were made; such personnel may be employed on such terms as authorized

by the Governor and may include the furnishing of travel, transportation and housing; the provisions of Title V, Government Code of Guam, shall not apply to such personnel, except as may be authorized by the Governor.
