AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE OFFICE OF  
THE GOVERNOR OF GUAM TO PROVIDE GRANTS FOR  
THE TRAINING OF RETARDED CHILDREN.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Office of the  
3 Governor of Guam from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus  
4 of the General Fund of the government of Guam the sum of Twenty-Seven  
5 Thousand Seventy-Six Dollars (\$27,076.00) for the purpose of providing  
6 for the training of retarded children. The Governor of Guam is author-  
7 ized to provide therefor through grants to private nonprofit organizations  
8 specifically organized and operated for such purposes.

9 Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
