
CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE MAINTENANCE OF THE GUAM CONGRESS BUILDING FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 1963.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from any available  
3 funds of the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund of the Government  
4 of Guam the sum of Thirty-Five Thousand Eight Hundred Dollars (\$35,800)  
5 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1963 for the maintenance of the Guam  
6 Congress Building, including but not limited to wages and salaries of  
7 janitors, janitorial and such other necessary supplies and equipment, and  
8 utilities excluding telephone. The appropriation herein made shall be  
9 administered in accordance with appropriate standing rules of the Guam  
10 Legislature.

11 Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
