AN ACT TO ADD SECTION 13505.1 TO CHAPTER 6, TITLE XIV. GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM. RELATIVE TO THE REQUIREMENT THAT THE DIRECTOR OF LAND MANAGEMENT PREPARE AN INVENTORY OF GOVERNMENT REAL PROPERTY AVAILABLE FOR SALE OR LEASE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 13505.1 is hereby added to Chapter 6. Title XIV. Government Code of Guam, to read as follows:

"Section 13505.1. Property Available for Lease or Sale. The Director shall annually prepare and submit to the Governor an inventory of all government real property available for disposition by lease or sale. Upon approval by the Governor such inventory shall be published on January 1 of each year, and at such other times as may be appropriate. Any deletions or additions shall be published in like manner. No application for lease or sale of real property shall be received except as to real property included in such inventory. No real property shall be included in such inventory which is needed by any department or agency of the government, or for any public use, including any projected future use."

Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
