
CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR

AN ACT TO ADD SECTION 13505.1 TO CHAPTER
6, TITLE XIV, GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM,
RELATIVE TO THE REQUIREMENT THAT THE
DIRECTOR OF LAND MANAGEMENT PREPARE AN
INVENTORY OF GOVERNMENT REAL PROPERTY
AVAILABLE FOR SALE OR LEASE.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 13505.1 is hereby added to Chapter 6, Title
3 XIV, Government Code of Guam, to read as follows:

4 "Section 13505.1. Property Available for Lease
5 or Sale. The Director shall annually prepare and submit
6 to the Governor an inventory of all government real
7 property available for disposition by lease or sale.
8 Upon approval by the Governor such inventory shall be
9 published on January 1 of each year, and at such other
10 times as may be appropriate. Any deletions or additions
11 shall be published in like manner. No application for
12 lease or sale of real property shall be received except
13 as to real property included in such inventory. No
14 real property shall be included in such inventory
15 which is needed by any department or agency of the
16 government, or for any public use, including any
17 projected future use."

18 Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
