Introduced by F. T. Ramirez

AN ACT TO REPEAL SECTION 4216, GOVERNMENT  
CODE OF GUAM, AND TO ENACT A NEW SECTION  
4216 RELATIVE TO PAYMENT OF ANNUITIES TO  
SURVIVING SPOUSE AND MINOR CHILDREN OF  
INACTIVE MEMBERS OF GOVERNMENT OF GUAM  
RETIREMENT FUND.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 4216 of Chapter 3, Title V, Government  
3 Code of Guam, is hereby repealed, and a new Section 4216 is hereby  
4 enacted to read as follows:

5 "Section 4216. Death of inactive member. Notwithstanding  
6 any other provision of this Chapter, upon the death of a member,  
7 not in service, who had completed at least 25 years of total  
8 service prior to his separation, if a surviving spouse or minor  
9 children survive the member, said surviving spouse, or guardian  
10 of surviving minor children if there is no surviving spouse,  
11 shall have the following options:

12 (a) The surviving spouse may elect to receive an annuity  
13 as provided under Section 4217(a)(1) or 4217(a)(2) whichever is  
14 applicable; or

15 (b) If only a minor child or children under age 18 years  
16 survive, the guardian of said child or children may elect for  
17 the child or children to receive the annuity provided under  
18 Section 4217(a)(3); or

19 (c) The surviving spouse, or guardian of surviving minor  
20 children if there is no surviving spouse, may elect to receive  
21 in lieu of the annuity above provided, a refund of the amount  
22 of the deceased member's accumulated contributions in the fund  
23 including regular interest to the date of death."

24 Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
