AN ACT TO ADD SECTION 4018 TO CHAPTER 1,
TITLE V, GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM, TO
AUTHORIZE GROUP INSURANCE FOR GOVERNMENT
OF GUAM EMPLOYEES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 4018 is hereby added to Chapter 1, Title V,
3 Government Code of Guam, to read as follows:

4 "Section 4018. Group Insurance. (a) The
5 Governor is authorized to enter contracts with one
6 or more insurance companies, authorized to do business
7 in Guam, for group insurance, including but not limited
8 to hospitalization, medical care, life, and accident,
9 for all employees or separate groups of employees of
10 the Government of Guam.

11 (b) All participation by employees in such
12 contracts of insurance shall be on a voluntary basis,
13 and all premiums for any such policies shall be paid
14 in full by the employees participating. Participation
15 by the Government of Guam shall be limited to providing
16 a payroll deduction for the payment of premiums.

17 (c) Contracts of insurance procured under the
18 foregoing may provide for participation by employees
19 of the Legislative and Judicial Branches, or such
20 branches may enter separate contracts for their employees
21 subject to the limitations set forth in this section.

22 (d) As used in this section, 'employees' includes
23 officers."

24 Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
