AN ACT TO SUSPEND SECTIONS 6118.1 AND 6118.2,  
CHAPTER 2, TITLE VII, GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM,  
RELATING TO THE TRANSFER AUTHORITY OF THE  
GOVERNOR FOR THE BALANCE OF THE FISCAL YEAR  
ENDING JUNE 30, 1963.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 6118.1 "Transfer Authority; Capital Improve-  
3 ment Appropriations" and Section 6118.2 "Save: Operating Appropriations"  
4 of Chapter 2, Title VII, Government Code of Guam, are hereby suspended and  
5 shall be of no force and effect during the period beginning on the effective  
6 date of this Act and ending on June 30, 1963. Thereafter, on July 1, 1963,  
7 said sections shall become effective and remain in full force and effect.

8 Section 2. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the  
9 Governor may transfer any item of appropriation for the operation of any  
10 department, agency or office of the Executive Branch, or any portion thereof,  
11 including any supplemental appropriation, without limitation, to any other  
12 item of appropriation for the operation of any department, agency or office  
13 of the Executive Branch, or to any appropriation made for a capital improve-  
14 ment or other specific project when necessary to avoid waste or undue delay  
15 in completing such improvement or project. A monthly statement of any trans-  
16 fers made pursuant to this section shall be submitted to the Legislature.  
17 The transfer authority contained herein shall terminate June 30, 1963.
