AN ACT MAKING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION
FOR EXECUTIVE BRANCH TRAVEL FOR THE FISCAL
YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 1963, AN APPROPRIATION
FOR THE WORKMEN'S COMPENSATION FUND, AND
FOR CLEANING DEBRIS.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. The sum of \$450,000 is hereby appropriated from any
3 available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund to
4 supplement the appropriation made by Section 5, Public Law 6-115, for
5 allowable travel and transportation expense of the Executive Branch of the
6 Government of Guam for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1963.

7 Section 2. The sum of \$10,000 is hereby appropriated from any
8 available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund for the
9 Workmen's Compensation Fund established by Section 37042 of the Government
10 Code of Guam.

11 Section 3. The sum of \$300,000 is hereby appropriated from any
12 available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund for clean-
13 ing of debris from public property.
