
CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR

AN ACT TO RETURN THE UNENCUMBERED BALANCE OF
CERTAIN PROJECT ACCOUNTS TO UNAPPROPRIATED
SURPLUS OF THE GENERAL FUND.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. The unencumbered balance of the following project
accounts, authorized and appropriated for by prior Acts are hereby returned
to the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund:

6 Section 2. The sum of \$384,000 is hereby reappropriated from the
 7 appropriation made by Section 4, Public Law 6-115, for the Executive Branch
 8 contribution to the Government of Guam Retirement Fund for the fiscal year
 9 ending June 30, 1963, and returned to Unappropriated Surplus of the General
 10 Fund.

11 Section 3. Notwithstanding any other provision of law the
 12 sum of \$600,000 in inactive capital reserves of the Public Utility Agency
 13 of Guam Fund is hereby transferred to the Unappropriated Surplus of the
 14 General Fund.

15 Section 4. The sum of \$250,000 is hereby transferred from the
 16 Land Transfer Fund to the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund.

17 Section 5. The sum of \$56,000 is hereby transferred from the
 18 Guam Memorial Hospital Fund to the Unappropriated Surplus of the General
 19 Fund.
