AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE CONTRACTS FOR ARCHITECTURAL SERVICES PRIOR TO RECEIPT OF FEDERAL DISASTER ASSISTANCE FUNDS THEREFOR.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAR:

Section 1. The Governor is authorized to enter into contracts for architectural services on bid basis when deemed necessary for preparation of plans and specifications for construction of government facilities for which Federal Disaster Assistance funds are to be made available. Costs in connection with such contracts, not to exceed a maximum of \$100,000,000, may be advanced from any available funds in the General Fund, to be reimbursed at such time as the Federal grant is received.

Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
