AN ACT TO AMEND SUBSECTION (7) OF SECTION 20002 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM RELATING TO THE ADMISSION TO PRACTICE LAW IN THE TERRITORY OF GUAM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUALS:

Section 1. Subsection (7) of Section 28002 of the Government Code of Guom is hereby muended to wood as follows:

"(7) He shall have either

- (a) graduated from a law school accredited by the American Bar Association, or
- (b) studied law diligently and in good faith for a period of at least tex (10) years in the office and under the preceptorship of a locally-admitted attorney (which attorney must have graduated from a law achool accredited by the American Bar Association) and been actually employed full time by suck attorney and satisfactorily passed a written excessiontion in law given by the semmittee of exeminers."

Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
