


CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR

Introduced by P. D. Falting

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 23339 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM PERTAINING TO THE PAYMENT OF REGISTRATION FEE UPON TRANSFER OF A MOTOR VEHICLE.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 23339 of the Government Code of Guam is hereby
3 amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 23339. Transfer of Registration. (a)
5 Registration expires on transfer by owner. Whenever the
6 owner of a registered vehicle transfers or assigns his
7 title, or interest thereto, the registration of such
8 vehicle shall expire. The owner shall remove the registration
9 plates therefrom and forward the same to the Department of
10 Finance, or may have such plates and the registration number
11 thereon assigned to another vehicle as provided in Section
12 23324(e).

13 (b) New owner must secure new registration. The
14 transferee before operating or permitting the operation of
15 such vehicle upon a highway shall apply for and obtain the
16 registration thereof, as upon an original registration,
17 except as otherwise permitted in (c) or (d) below, and
18 except that no registration fee other than a two-dollar
19 charge for the cost of new plates and new registration
20 certificates, shall be imposed for such registration.

21 (c) Transfers to dealers. When the transferee of a
22 vehicle is a dealer who holds the same for resale and law-
23 fully operates the same under dealer's number plates or
24 when the transferee does not drive such vehicle or permit
25 it to be driven upon the highways, such transferee shall
26 not be required to obtain a new registration of such
27 vehicle.

1 (d) Transfer by operation of law. Whenever the
2 title or interest of an owner in or to a registered vehicle
3 shall pass to another otherwise than by voluntary transfer,
4 the registration shall expire and the vehicle shall not
5 be operated upon the highways unless and until the person
6 entitled to possession of such vehicle shall apply for
7 and obtain the registration thereof."

8 Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
