AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 12168 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAN TO REQUIRE THE PRESENCE OF THE MUNICIPAL COMMIS-SIGNER AT THE TIME OF BRANDING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAR:
Section 1. Section 12168 of the Government Code of Guam is hereby

amended to read as follows:

"Section 12168. Use of Brand. (a) No person shall apply any brand to any livestock or other animal without the permission of the owner of the brand.

- (b) No person shall apply any brand to any livestock or other animal not owned by him without the permission of the owner of such animal.
- (c) No person shall apply a brand to any livestock or other animal unless the Commissioner or Deputy Commissioner of the respective district in Guam where the branding occurs is present.
- (d) Any person violating subsection (a), subsection (b), or subsection (c) of this section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be subject to a fine of not less than \$50 nor more than \$500, or to imprisonment for not more than one (1) year, or both."

 Section 2. This Act is an argency measure.
