

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 12313, OF ARTICLE
I, CHAPTER 4, TITLE XIII, GOVERNMENT CODE
OF GUAM, RELATIVE TO UNPROTECTED WILD
BIRDS.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 12313, Government Code of Guam, is hereby amended
3 to read as follows:

4 "Section 12313. Unprotected Wild Birds. The following
5 wild birds may be taken in the daytime:

- 6 (a) Crows
7 (b) Marianas Starlings
8 (c) Woodpeckers (kingfishers)
9 (d) Black-headed manikins
10 (e) European tree sparrows
11 (f) Java Sparrows."

12 Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
