## Substitute bill by Committee on Military and Veterans' Affairs

AN ACT TO ADD SECTION 20004.2 TO THE GOVERN-MENT CODE OF GUAM TO AUTHORIZE THE GUAM FINANCE AND DEVELOPMENT ADMINISTRATION TO MAKE VETERANS' LOANS TO GUAM VETERANS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:
Section 1. Section 20004.2 is hereby added to the Government Code of
Guam to read as follows:

Section 20004.2. Direct loans to veterans. To assist in the housing, agricultural, commercial, or industrial pursuits of voting residents of Guam who are veterans of the Armed Forces of the United States, who served either during the second World War or during the Korean Conflict and who were honorably discharged from service, the Guam Finance Agency may make direct loans to such veterans. Such loans shall be made from the Finance Agency Guarantee Fund and upon such terms and conditions and under such rules and regulations as the Board may prescribe. It is the intent of the Legislature that such loans may be made to such veterans whether or not adequate financing is available on reasonable terms from a lending agency. No loan in excess of Fourteen Thousand Dollars (\$14,000) shall be made for the construction of a new home provided that up to One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500) of such amount may be used to purchase a homesite.

Notwithstanding any provision of law, the reserve set aside by Section 20004.1 of the Government Code of Guam shall be made available to carry out the provisions of this Section, but only for construction of new homes and the purchase of homesites.

Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
