AN ACT MAKING SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS FOR CERTAIN CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAR:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of Forty-Five Thousand Bollars (\$45,000.00) for construction of temporary classrooms.

Section 2. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of Fifty Thousand Dellars (\$50,000.00) for the preparation of a Master Harbor Development Plan by the United States Navy.

Section 3. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the following sums to supplement prior appropriations and/or appropriated receipts for the projects set forth herein:

- (a) Aget Fire Station \$ 15,000
- (b) Agat Commissioner's Office 3,000
- (c) Tamuning Fire Station 20,000
- (d) Yona Commissioner's Office 2,000
- (e) Additional Classrooms at

Inarajan School 25,000

(f) Rehabilitation of

Recreational Facilities 50,000

Section 4. The sum of Three Hundred Thousand Dollars

(\$300,000.00) is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the

Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund to the Public Utility Agency

Zund.

Section 5. The appropriations made by this Act shall be effective immediately, and shall be available for all expenses incident to the purposes for which made. Every appropriation made herein shall continue in full force and effect and shall be available until expended for the project for which the appropriation is made or until the project is completed. Appropriations made for capital improvements under this and prior acts may be used for the employment of technical, professional and other skilled personnel for use on capital improvement projects for which such appropriations were made; such personnel may be employed on such terms as authorized by the Governor and may include the furnishing of travel, transportation and housing; the provisions of Title V.

Government Code of Guam, shall not apply to such personnel, except as may be authorized by the Governor.
