

AN ACT MAKING SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS
FOR CERTAIN CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS
AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from any available
3 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of
4 forty-five Thousand Dollars (\$45,000.00) for construction of temporary
5 classrooms.

6 Section 2. There is hereby appropriated from any available
7 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of
8 Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) for the preparation of a Master
9 Harbor Development Plan by the United States Navy.

10 Section 3. There is hereby appropriated from any available
11 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the following
12 sums to supplement prior appropriations and/or appropriated receipts
13 for the projects set forth herein:

14	(a) Agat Fire Station	\$ 15,000
15	(b) Agat Commissioner's Office	3,000
16	(c) Tamuning Fire Station	20,000
17	(d) Yona Commissioner's Office	2,000
18	(e) Additional Classrooms at	
19	Inarajan School	25,000
20	(f) Rehabilitation of	
21	Recreational Facilities	50,000

22 Section 4. The sum of Three Hundred Thousand Dollars
23 (\$300,000.00) is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the
24 Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund to the Public Utility Agency

1 Fund.

2 Section 5. The appropriations made by this Act shall be
3 effective immediately, and shall be available for all expenses incident
4 to the purposes for which made. Every appropriation made herein shall
5 continue in full force and effect and shall be available until expended
6 for the project for which the appropriation is made or until the project
7 is completed. Appropriations made for capital improvements under this
8 and prior acts may be used for the employment of technical, professional
9 and other skilled personnel for use on capital improvement projects
10 for which such appropriations were made; such personnel may be employed
11 on such terms as authorized by the Governor and may include the furnishing
12 of travel, transportation and housing; the provisions of Title V,
13 Government Code of Guam, shall not apply to such personnel, except as
14 may be authorized by the Governor.
