AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE OFFICE  
OF THE GOVERNOR OF GUAM FOR THE TRAINING  
OF RETARDED CHILDREN.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Office of the  
3 Governor of Guam from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus  
4 of the General Fund the sum of Sixty-Eight Thousand Eight Hundred and  
5 Eighty Dollars (\$68,880.00) to continue providing facilities for the  
6 training of retarded children.

7 Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
