AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR OF GUAN FOR THE TRAINING OF RETAINED CHILDREN.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PROPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAR:

Section 1.
