

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE ONE THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED  
DOLLARS (\$1,600) TO PROVIDE FOR THE INSTALLATION  
OF FLOOD LIGHTS AT THE BASKETBALL COURT IN THE  
MUNICIPALITY OF YONA.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from any available  
3 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund of the Government  
4 of Guam, the sum of One Thousand Six Hundred Dollars (\$1,600) to the  
5 Department of Public Works to provide for the installation of flood lights  
6 at the basketball court in the Municipality of Yona.

7 Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
