SEVENTH GUAN LEGISLATURE 1963 (FIRST) Regular Session Bill No. 97 Substitute bill by Committee on Agriculture and Commerce AN ACT TO AMEND TITLE XV OF. AND TO ENACT A NEW TITLE XLIV TO, THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAN, RELATIVE TO THE SEPARATION OF THE COMMERCIAL PORT AND DEPART-MENT OF COMMERCE, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES. 1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GIAM: 2 Section 1. The title of Title XV. Government Code of Guam. is 3 hereby emended to read as follows: "Commercial Port of Guam" 4 5 Section 2. Section 14000 of Chapter 1, Title XV, Government Code of Guam, is hereby amended to read as follows: 6 "Section 14000. Separate instrumentality. The 7 8 Commercial Port of Guam is a separate instrumentality 9 within the government of Guam. All property, facilities, 10 equipment, supplies, records and files pertaining to and 11 used in connection with the operation, protection and 12 administration of the Commercial Port of Guam are transferred 13 and assigned to said instrumentality. All personnel used in 14 the administration, protection and operation of the Commercial 15 Port are also transferred and assigned to said instrumentality." Section 3. Section 14001 of Chapter 1, Title XV, Government Code 16 17 of Guam, is repealed in its entirety and a new Section 14001 is hereby enacted to read as follows: 18 "Section 14001, Commercial Port Manager, The Commercial 19 20 Port Manager is the head of the Commercial Port of Guam and 21 is appointed by the Governor with the consent of the Legislature." Section 4. Subsection (c) of Section 14002, Government Code of 22 23 Guam, is hereby amended to read as follows: 24 "(c) All monies received by the Commercial Port of Guam from whatever source derived shall be deposited in 25

said Commercial Port of Guam Fund. All debts, liabilities 1 2 and obligations, capital expenditures, and operating expenses 3 of the said Commercial Port, including the payment of any claims arising from its operation, shall be paid from said 4 5 fund. The Commercial Port Manager is hereby authorized to settle and pay any and all cargo and property damage claims 6 arising out of the operations of the Commercial Port of Guan, 7 8 up to and including the value of \$25.00. Where the claim is C greater than \$25.00, in value, the Commercial Port Manager is 10 hereby authorized, subject to the legal review and approval of the Attorney General of Guam, to settle and pay any and all 11 12 cargo and property damage claims arising out of the operations of the Commercial Port of Guam; provided, however, that such 13 claims must be presented to the Commercial Port of Guam within 14 one year after the accrual thereof in order to be paid as 15 provided herein." 16 17 Section 5. Subsection (d) of Section 14002, Government Code of Guam, is hereby amended to read as follows: 18 "(d) The Commercial Port Manager shall render monthly 19 to the Governor a statement reflecting the financial condition 20 of the Commercial Port of Guam Fund and a financial statement 21 of operations of said Commercial Port for the period covered. 22 The Director of Finance shall periodically audit the accounts 23 and records of said Commercial Port of Guam Fund and render 24 a report thereon to the Governor." 25 Section 6. Subsection (e) of Section 14002, Government Code of 26 Guan, is hereby repealed, and a new Subsection (e) is hereby enacted to read 27 as follows: 28 "(e) The Commercial Port of Guam shall be a nonprofit. 29 self-supporting agency; rates charged for its services shall 30 be reviewed not less than once a year and, if necessary, 31 adjusted to accomplish this result." 32 - 2 -

| 30         | Section 8. Section 14100 of the Government Code of Guam is hereby |
| 31         | amended to read as follows:                                       |
| 32         | "Section 14100. Harbor Regulation. The Commercial                 |
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Port Manager shall make periodic surveys of the use, supervision, control and management of the shores, shore waters, navigable streams, harbors, harbor and waterfront improvements, ports, docks, wharves, quays, bulkheads and landings belonging to or controlled by the territory of Guam and the shipping using the same. The Commercial Port Manager shall fix and regulate from time to time rates for services rendered in mooring or berthing vessels, charges for the use of moorings or berths belonging to or controlled by the territory of Guam, rates or charges for the services of pilots, wharfage or demurrage, rents or charges for warehouse space, office, office space, storage of freight, goods, wares and merchandise, use of equipment belonging to or controlled by the territory of Guam, and other charges including toll or tonnage charges on freight passing over or across wharves, docks, quays, bulkheads or landings." Section 9. Section 14101 of the Government Code of Guam is hereby amended to read as follows:

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"Section 14101. Rules and Regulations. The Commercial Port Manager shall make and may alter, amend and repeal rules, regulations, fees and rates as required to carry out the purposes of this chapter, which, after approval and promulgation by the Governor as executive order, shall have the force and effect of 1aw. Provided, however, that nothing in this chapter shall be construed to alter, amend or repeal any rules, regulations, fees and rates in force and effect on the effective date hereof; and provided further, that such rules, regulations, fees, or rates may be made, altered, amended or repealed by the Commercial Port Manager only upon the basis of evidence taken at public hearing. Public notice of such hearing shall be published at least twice in a newspaper of general circulation in Guam, not more than thirty (30)

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nor less than ten (10) days prior to the scheduled date for such hearing, and by such other method as the Commercial Port Manager may prescribed."

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Section 10. Section 14102 of the Government Code of Guam is hereby amended to read as follows:

> "Section 14102. Hearing. For the purpose of conducting any hearing as required by this chapter, the Commercial Port Manager is empowered to subpoens witnesses, books and records, administer eaths, and examine evidence and hear testimony. The Commercial Port Manager is empowered to certify to the District Court of Guam for contempt and such certifications and all subsequent proceedings and penalties for contempt before the Commercial Port Manager shall be in accordance with Section 24138, Government Code of Guam."

Section 11. Chapter 3, Title XV, Government Code of Guam, is hereby renumbered Chapter 2, Title XLIV, Government Code of Guam, and Sections 14200, 14201, 14202, 14203, 14204, 14205, 14206, 14207, 14208, 14209, 14210, 14211, 14212, 14213, 14214, 14215, 14216, 14217, 14218, 14219, 14220, 14221, 14222, 14223, 14224, 14225, 14226, 14227, 14228, 14229, 14230, 14231, 14232, 14233, 14234, and 14235 of said Chapter are hereby renumbered Sections 47100, 47101, 47102, 47103, 47104, 47105, 47106, 47107, 47108, 47109, 47110, 47111, 47112, 47113, 47114, 47115, 47116, 47117, 47118, 47119, 47120, 47121, 47122, 47123, 47124, 47125, 47126, 47127, 47128, 47129, 47130, 47131, 47132, 47133, 47134, 47135, and 47136, respectively.

Section 12. Chapter 4, Title XV, Government Code of Guam, is hereby renumbered Chapter 3, Title XLIV, Government Code of Guam, and Sections 14300, 14300.1, 14301, 14302, 14303, 14304, 14304.1, 14305, 14306, 14307, 14308, 14309, 14310, and 14311 of said Chapter are hereby renumbered Sections 47200, 47201, 47202, 47203, 47204, 47205, 47206, 47207, 47208, 47209, 47210, 47211, 47212, and 47213, respectively.

Section 13. Effective date. This Act shall take effect July 1, 1963.

Section 14. This Act is an urgency measure.
