


CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR

AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR NECESSARY
CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS AND FOR OTHER
PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. There are hereby appropriated from any available funds
in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund, the following sums for
the purposes set forth herein:

- (a) To continue the Highway and Pavement Program \$250,000
- (b) To provide for the construction and purchase of collateral equipment for the Merizo Elementary School \$ 35,000
- (c) To provide for the construction and purchase of collateral equipment for the Dededo Elementary School \$ 31,000
- (d) To provide for the construction of school bus shelters \$ 11,000
- (e) To provide for the improvement of the Science Laboratory Facilities in the Department of Education \$ 14,000
- (f) To provide for the purchase and rental of automotive equipment for the Executive Branch \$214,350

Section 2. The sum of Four Hundred Forty-Eight Thousand Dollars (\$448,000) is hereby appropriated, from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund, for travel and transportation for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1964.

1 Section 3. The sum of Three Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars
2 (\$350,000) is hereby appropriated, from any available funds in the
3 Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund, for the Executive Branch
4 contribution to the Government of Guam Retirement Fund for the fiscal
5 year ending June 30, 1964.

6 Section 4. The sum of Three Hundred Eighty-Four Thousand Dollars
7 (\$384,000) is hereby appropriated, from any available funds in the
8 Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund, for the Executive Branch
9 contribution to the Government of Guam Retirement Fund for the fiscal
10 year ending June 30, 1963.

11 Section 5. The sum of One Hundred Ten Thousand Dollars (\$110,000)
12 is hereby appropriated, from any available funds in the Unappropriated
13 Surplus of the General Fund, for the Land Transfer Fund.

14 Section 6. The appropriations made by this Act shall be effective
15 immediately, and shall be available for all expenses incident to the purposes
16 for which made. Every appropriation made herein shall continue in full
17 force and effect and shall be available until expended for the project for
18 which the appropriation is made or until the project is completed.
19 Appropriations made for capital improvements under this and prior Acts
20 may be used for the employment of technical, professional and other skilled
21 personnel for use on capital improvement projects for which such appropria-
22 tions were made; such personnel may be employed on such terms as authorized
23 by the Governor and may include the furnishing of travel, transportation
24 and housing; the provisions of Title V, Government Code of Guam, shall not
25 apply to such personnel, except as may be authorized by the Governor.

26 Section 7. This Act is an urgency measure.
