AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR NECESSARY CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GRAM:

Section 1. There are hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund, the following sums for the purposes set forth berein:

Section 2. The sam of Four Hundred Forty-Eight Thousand Dellars (\$448,000) is hereby appropriated, from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund, for travel and transportation for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1964.

Section 3. The sum of Three Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$350,000) is hereby appropriated, from any available funds is the 2 Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund, for the Executive Branch 3 contribution to the Government of Guam Betirement Fund for the fiscal 4 year ending June 30, 1964. 5 6 7 8 9 10 year ending June 30, 1963. 11 12 Surplus of the General Fund, for the Land Transfer Fund. 13 14

Section 4. The sum of Three Hundred Eighty-Four Thousand Dollars . (\$384,000) is kereby appropriated, from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund, for the Executive Branch contribution to the Government of Guam Retirement Fund for the fiscal

Section 5. The sum of One Hundred Ten Thousand Dollars (\$110,000) is hereby appropriated. from any available funds in the Cnappropriated

Section 6. The appropriations made by this Act shall be effective immediately, and shall be evailable for all expenses incident to the purposes for which made. Every appropriation made herein shall continue in full force and effect and shall be available until expended for the project for which the appropriation is made or until the project is completed. Appropriations made for capital improvements under this and prior Acts may be used for the employment of technical, professional and other skilled personnel for use on capital improvement projects for which such appropriations were made: such personnel may be employed on such terms as authorized by the Governor and may include the furnishing of travel, transportation and housing; the provisions of Title V. Government Code of Guam, shall not apply to such personnel, except as may be nuthorized by the Governor.

Section 7. This Act is an urgency measure.
