
CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT IN THE CHAMBERS.

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO IMPROVE THE
FACILITIES OF THE DISTRICT COURT OF GUAM
AND THE ISLAND COURT OF GUAM.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds
3 in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund of the Government of Guam,
4 the sum of Sixty Thousand Dollars (\$60,000) to the Legislature to provide
5 for the improvement of the facilities of the District Court of Guam and the
6 Island Court of Guam in the Guam Congress Building by way of providing
7 adequate sound proofing and related electrical facilities.

8 Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
