AN ACT

An Act making an appropriation for the continuation of construction of swimming and sanitary facilities at Ipao Beach and for other purposes.

Be it enacted by the People of the Territory of Guam:

Section 1. The sum of Sixty Thousand Dollars (\$60,000) is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund for the continuation of construction of swimming and sanitary facilities at Ipao Beach.

Section 2. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of Ten Thousand (\$10,000) Dollars for the improvement of the existing Tai Road.

Section 3. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of Twenty-Eight Thousand Dollars (\$28,000) to supplement prior appropriations for the construction of permanent or temporary station and purchase of equipment for inspection of vehicles.

Section 4. This Act is an urgency measure.
