
CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR

AN ACT TO RENUMBER SECTION 43258, GOVERNMENT CODE
OF GUAM, AND TO ENACT A NEW SECTION 43258 TO THE
GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM CONCERNING INSURANCE
ADJUSTERS.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 43258 of Article VII, Chapter 2, Title XXXIX,
3 Government Code of Guam, is hereby renumbered Section 43259 of Article VII,
4 Chapter 2, Title XXXIX, Government Code of Guam.

5 Section 2. A new Section 43258 is hereby added to Article VII,
6 Chapter 2, Title XXXIX, Government Code of Guam, to read as follows:

7 "Section 43258. Insurance Adjusters. No person,
8 except a person otherwise licensed under this article,
9 shall make any adjustment under an insurance policy
10 covering hazards described in Article I of Chapter 3 of
11 this Title, unless he shall hold a license under this
12 section or is exempted therefrom.

13 (a) An insurance adjuster's license may be issued by
14 the Commissioner to any person filing an application on a
15 prescribed form and upon payment of a license fee of ten
16 dollars (\$10.00). Licenses and renewals thereof shall be
17 for a term expiring one year after date of issue.

18 (b) Any license under this section may be refused,
19 suspended or revoked for any of the reasons set forth in
20 Section 43253 of this Title and in the manner so provided
21 therein."
