AN ACT TO ADD SECTION 4110.3 TO THE
GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO PROHIBIT
FROM HIRING BY CONTRACT SPECIALISTS
NOT POSSESSING UNIQUE QUALIFICATIONS
NOT AVAILABLE IN THE TERRITORY.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 4110.3 is hereby added to the Government Code of
3 Guam to read as follows:

4 "Section 4110.3. Prohibition. No contract for
5 the hiring of officers or employees for the Government of
6 Guam from the Continental United States or elsewhere,
7 pursuant to Section 4110 of this title, may be executed
8 after March 1, 1964, with any person who does not have
9 either unique skills or other qualifications not available
10 among the residents of Guam. Prior to the execution of any
11 such contract after March 1, 1964, the Director of the
12 Department of Labor and Personnel must certify to the
13 Governor of Guam that the person to be employed by such
14 contract possesses either skills or qualifications not
15 possessed by any resident of Guam available for hire for
16 the position to be filled by said contract."
