Public Law 7-75 Seventh Guam Legislature (Bill 190) January 30, 1964

AN ACT

An Act to add Section 23319.1 to the Government Code of Guam pertaining to motor vehicle licenses for amateur or citizens radio station operators.

Be it enacted by the People of the Territory of Guam:

Section 1. Section 23319.1 is hereby added to the Government Code of Guam to read as follows:

"Section 23319.1. Same: Amateur or citizens radio station licenses. Any person holding an unexpired amateur or citizens radio station license, other than a novice license, issued by the Federal Communications Commission may, upon registering a vehicle, also apply to the Department for a special license plate, to be fixed to the vehicle, on which, in lieu of the number otherwise prescribed, shall be inscribed the official amateur or citizens radio station call letters of the applicant as assigned by the Federal Communications Commission.

The applicant shall by satisfactory proof show that he is the holder of an unexpired license, and in addition to the regular registration fee, may be charged a fee not exceeding five dollars (\$5.00) for such license plate when issued and whenever the vehicle or the ownership of the vehicle for which plates are issued, is changed.

After the requirements for the registration of the vehicle have been complied with, the Depart-

ment shall issue such plate in lieu of the regular license plate. The Department shall not issue more than one (1) set of special plate for any licensed amateur or citizens radio station."

Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
