AN ACT

An Act to amend Section 81 of Chapter III, Title I, of Part I, Code of Civil Procedure, relative to the tenure of judges of the Island Court.

*Be it enacted by the People of the Territory of Guam:*

Section 1. Section 81 of the Code of Civil Procedure is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 81. Appointment, tenure and salary of judges. The Island Court shall consist of a chief judge and such additional judges as may be necessary for the proper dispatch of the business of the court, who shall be appointed by the Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature, for terms of eight years each, unless sooner removed for cause. The salary of the chief judge and of the other judges shall be fixed by law and shall not be diminished during their terms of office."

Section 2. The Governor may, with the advice and consent of the Legislature, reappoint any judge of the Island Court under the provisions of this Act, notwithstanding that the term to which said Judge was appointed under the prior law may not have expired.

Section 3. This Act is an urgency measure.
