Public Law 7-82 Seventh Guam Legislature (Bill 184) February 5, 1964

AN ACT

An Act to add a new Subsection (c) to Section 23110 of Chapter 2, Title XXIV, Government Code of Guam, relative to objects obstructing a driver's view.

Be it enacted by the People of the Territory of Guam:

Section 1. A new Subsection (c) is hereby added to Section 23110 of Chapter 2, Title XXIV, Government Code of Guam, to read as follows:

"(c) No person shall drive any motor vehicle upon a highway with any object or material so placed in or upon the vehicle as to obstruct or reduce the driver's clear view through the windshield, except required or permitted equipment of the vehicle and adjustable non-transparent sun visors which are not attached to the glass."

Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
