AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 27202(c) OF THE
GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM, RELATIVE TO THE
LICENSURE OF NURSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 27202(c) of Chapter 3, Title XXVIII, Government
Code of Guam, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"(c) Duties and Powers

The Board shall meet annually in the
month of January and shall elect from
its members a chairman and a vice
chairman. It may hold such other
meetings during the year as may be deemed
necessary to transact its business. A
majority of the Board including one
officer, shall constitute a quorum at
any meeting. The Board is authorized to:

1. Adopt and, from time to time, revise
such rules and regulations not incon-
sistent with the law, as may be necessary
to enable it to carry into effect the
provisions of this Act; and
2. Prescribe criteria and standards for
educational programs preparing persons
for licensure under this Act; and
3. Provide for surveys of such programs
at such times as it may deem necessary;
and

- 1 4. Approve such programs as meet
2 the requirements of this Act and
3 of the Board; and
- 4 5. Deny or withdraw approval from
5 educational programs for failure
6 to meet prescribed criteria or
7 other standards; and
- 8 6. Give the State National Board Test
9 Pool examination. These tests are
10 given according to the rules
11 formulated by the ANA Committee
12 of State Boards of Nursing and are
13 included in the contract signed by
14 the National League for Nursing and
15 the Guam Board of Nurse Examiners; and
- 16 7. To license and renew the licenses of
17 duly qualified applicants; and
- 18 8. Issue a temporary work permit as
19 described in Section 27203(b) (3); and
- 20 9. Conduct hearings upon charges calling
21 for discipline of licensee; and
- 22 10. Have the power to issue subpoenas, and
23 compel the attendance of witnesses,
24 and administer oaths to persons giving
25 testimony at hearings, and may enforce
26 compliance upon application to the
27 Island Court; and
- 28 11. Cause the prosecution of all persons
29 violating this Act and have power to
30 incur such necessary expenses in
31 procuring necessary witnesses therefor; and

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- 12. Keep a record of all its proceedings; and
- 13. Make an annual report to the Governor; and
- 14. Appoint and employ a qualified person who shall not be a member of the board to serve as executive officer to the board; and
- 15. Define the duties and fix the compensation for executive officer; and
- 16. Employ such other persons as may be necessary to carry on the work of the board.

The executive officer shall meet all the qualifications for Board members."

Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
